# Modifications from V1.2L20 to V1.2L30

Modified the following errors:

- B&W images are occasionally displayed in reverse on the [Book Image Viewer] screen. In addition, the black and white colors may be reversed when a corrected B&W image is saved in the [Book Image Viewer] window.
- B&W images are occasionally displayed in reverse on the [Remove Newspaper Background Color] window.
- Files are not stored in Evernote on macOS Sierra.

# Modifications from V1.2L10 to V1.2L20

- Additional languages are available for converting files into searchable PDF. To add these languages, you need to install the OCR Pack that includes the language you want to use from Online Update first.
- Modified the error where ScanSnap Sync option cannot connect to OneDrive.
- The icon designs have been changed.

# Modifications from V1.1L50 to V1.2L10

- ScanSnap Sync has been added. ScanSnap Sync allows you to use the images scanned with ScanSnap anywhere at any time with a cloud service to automatically sync the data between ScanSnap Organizer and ScanSnap Connect Application in your mobile device.
- Modified the program so that the save destination for the images scanned with ScanSnap Manager can be changed.
- Modified the program so that any files added to a subfolder can be converted into PDF files automatically.
- The linked application name [Scan to Google Docs(TM)] has been changed to [Scan to Google Drive].

- A new option has been added so that files can be saved to CardMinder.

- A modification has been made so that point-retouched results can be applied to the original scanned image of "flat document" in Book Image Viewer.
