Before Using This Service

This section provides the information that super administrators need to know before using the EdgeXperience Capture Service.

Overview

The EdgeXperience Capture Service is a cloud service (SaaS) that connects a managed scanner to the EdgeXperience Capture Service and saves scanned document images to a designated location.

System Requirements

User Types

There are three types of EdgeXperience Capture Service users.

- SuperAdmin SuperAdmins configure the authentication method for EdgeXperience Capture Service.

In addition, they can perform the operations that administrators and users are able to

perform.

and set jobs. In addition, they can perform the operations that users are able to perform.

- Users perform jobs using EdgeXperience Capture Service.

HINT

A job is a collection of settings that allows users to scan documents from a scanner and save images to a destination.

The settings such as scanning profile and save destination are configured in the job.

Preferences

This section describes the configuration flow for the EdgeXperience Capture Service as performed by a super administrator.

Deployment

This section describes the deployment of the EdgeXperience Capture Service.

Subscribe EdgeXperience Capture Service from Microsoft® Azure Marketplace

After subscription, a URL and tenant code for logging into the administrator window (on the web portal) will be sent to the subscriber's email address used to subscribe the service.

Use the account you used to subscribe EdgeXperience Capture Service from Microsoft® Azure Marketplace, to log into the EdgeXperience Capture Service administrator window (on the web portal) from a browser and configure the preferences.

HINT

A tenant code is the information used to configure the scanner to connect to the EdgeXperience Capture Service. It is not the tenant ID of Microsoft® Azure. The settings such as scanning profile and save destination are configured in the job.

Configuration

This section describes the configuration of the EdgeXperience Capture Service.

The first time you log into the administrator window (on the web), the wizard starts automatically. You can setup job and job group for initial test (You can also start the wizard by clicking the following icon). This step is optional.



HINT

If you select the "Manual Configuration" in the wizard, jobs and job groups are not created.

Next step, you need to configure the authentication settings in the following window.

[Authentication] Window

Click [Authentication] in the left menu in the administrator window (on the web portal).

Authentication Method

Select the method for logging into the EdgeXperience Capture Service from the scanner.

Username/Password or NFC

Select when managing jobs for users.

Log in with either username or NFC card.

User Code/PIN or NFC

Select when managing jobs for users.

Log in with either user code or NFC card.

For details on user code and PIN, refer to EdgeXperience Capture Service User's Guide for AdminUser.

HINT

When [Azure Active Directory] is selected for [Managing Account] and Multi-Factor Authentication is enabled on Azure AD, you must select the [User Code/PIN or NFC] for [Authentication Method].

Scanner

Select when managing jobs for scanners.

Log in automatically after turning on the scanner.

HINT

You can change the authentication method after the service starts operation.

Changing the authentication method removes the association between the job group and the user or scanner, and you must reconfigure the job group again. For more information on job groups, refer to EdgeXperience Capture Service User's Guide for AdminUser.

Managing Account

Select the method for managing user accounts. You must select one regardless of the authentication method.

Local Account

Use EdgeXperience Capture Service to manage users.

Azure Active Directory

Use Azure AD to manage users.

Enter a Microsoft® Azure tenant ID to retrieve user information

Tenant ID

When [Azure Active Directory] is selected for [Managing Account], enter a Microsoft® Azure tenant ID.

Group Name

When [Azure Active Directory] is selected for [Managing Account], enter a group name of Azure AD. Only users in the group are synced and displayed in the user list. Groups are not displayed in the user list. If no group name is entered, all users of Azure AD are synced.

HINT

- You can specify a nested group. If you have multiple groups that you want to sync, create a group with those groups as members.
- Azure AD allows whitespace at the beginning or end of the group name. The group name entered here will not be trimmed, so please enter the same as the Azure AD group name.

Save

Save the settings. When [Azure Active Directory] is selected for [Managing Account], Microsoft® Azure sign-in window will be displayed.

Sign in with an account that has Azure AD Administrator rights, and grant EdgeXperience Capture Service access to Azure AD.

Administrators Creation

This section describes the creation of the EdgeXperience Capture Service administrators.

Super administrators create administrators after setting up the authentication method and account management method.

Click [User] in the left menu in the administrator window (on the web portal) to create administrators. For details on creating administrators, refer to EdgeXperience Capture Service User's Guide for AdminUser.
